

Board of Supervisors Minutes
January 12, 2022
Special Meeting

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 9:30 a.m. January 12, 2022. Present: 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson. 1st District Supervisor, Larry Vest, was absent.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve the minutes of the January 10th regular meeting and the January 11th special meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

At 10:00 the Board held the third and final reading of proposed Ordinance #I.5 Ordinance Establishing the Tama County Voting Precincts. Copies of the new proposed ordinance can be obtained in the Tama County Auditor's Office, 104 West State Street Toledo. There were no public comments. The hearing/reading was closed at 10:01 am. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve the 3rd and final reading of proposed Ordinance #I.5 Ordinance Establishing the Tama County Voting Precincts and the following resolution to adopt Ordinance #I.5 Ordinance Establishing the Tama County Voting Precincts and authorize its publication:

Ordinance #I.5 Ordinance Establishing Tama County Voting Precincts

WHEREAS, the Board has held three public readings, one each on January 10th, 11th, and 12th, 2022, concerning the proposed Ordinance #I.5 Ordinance Establishing Tama County Voting Precincts,

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance provides for the establishment of all election precincts in conjunction with the most recent federal decennial census of Tama County, IA to be effective January 15, 2022. This proposed ordinance completely replaces the present Tama County Ordinance #I.4 in the Tama County Code of Ordinances,

WHEREAS, there were no written or verbal objections to the proposed Ordinance I.5,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, upon final publication of this Ordinance it be enrolled in the County's book of ordinances and in effect on the date of publication.
