Special Meeting to Canvas Tama County Special Election Results

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. March 7, 2022. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Larry Vest; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

The Board met to do the First Tier Canvas of the South Tama Special School Elections held on March 1, 2022. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Vest to approve the following resolution:

CERTIFICATION (CANVASS) OF TAMA COUNTY ELECTION RESULTS,
SPECIAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the SPECIAL ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on March 1, 2022, and WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers have canvassed the vote of said election in accordance with §50.24 of the *Code of Iowa*, now therefore BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Tama County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the SPECIAL ELECTION, held March 1, 2022, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

One thousand one hundred fifty-six (1,156) people voted at the polls on election day.

Eighty-one (81) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

A total of one thousand two hundred thirty-seven (1,237) people voted.
