BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of Canvassers of Tama County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT REPORT and RESULTS in the SPECIAL ELECTION, held March 7, 2023, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Seven hundred seventy-six (776) people voted at the polls on election day.

Ninety-two (92) absentee ballots were accepted for counting.

A total of eight hundred sixty-eight (868) people voted.
