Board of Supervisors Minutes December 4, 2023

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. December 4, 2023. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson. 8:30 – 9:15 Employee/Department Head Time

9:15 – 9:30 Public Comment on Agenda Items The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present: Supervisors Hilmer, Faircloth, Anderson. Tama County Auditor Laura Kopsa, Assistant Auditor Karen Rohrs, members of the public. Deputy Sheriff Schmidt was also present. There were no public comments today.

9:30 Motion by Anderson, seconded by Hilmer to approve the minutes of the November 27th regular meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. Daleske also presented four funding agreements for bridge replacements on P Avenue, E Avenue, F Avenue and 220th Street. Motion by Hilmer, seconded by Anderson to approve these agreements and authorize the chairman to sign said documents on behalf of the Tama County Board of Supervisors. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Hilmer to appoint Kelly Smith, Toledo, to the Compensation Board as requested by the Recorder. This term will run through June 30, 2026. All vote Aye. Motion carried.

Rob Fattig, Chelsea, and Dan Poduska, Chelsea, were present to discuss a possible tax certificate reassignment and abatement. Tama County has held tax certificate #18-0201 since 2018. The total amount due, including taxes, interest and other costs is \$17,043.93. Mr. Fattig proposes paying one fourth the taxes due in the amount of \$2,479 and asking the Supervisors to abate \$7,437 of the taxes, \$6,570 interest, \$156 of the interest and costs on a special assessment for Poweshiek Water and \$16.00 other. This would get the property back on the tax rolls. There was discussion between the Supervisors, Fattig and Poduska. Motion by Hilmer, seconded by Anderson to re-assign Tama County Tax Certificate #18-0201 to Robert Fattig for \$4,958 (one half of the taxes) and \$385.93 for the special assessment and abate the rest of the taxes, interest and other. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Anderson, seconded by Hilmer to approve the claims for payment as presented. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Chairman Faircloth adjourned the meeting at 9:58 a.m.
