

Board of Supervisors Minutes
November 18, 2024

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. November 18, 2024. Present: 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson. 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth joined by phone. 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer was absent. Also present were Tama County Auditor Laura Kopsa, Assistant Auditor Karen Rohrs, and members of the public.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to approve the agenda. All voted aye. Motion carried.
