

Board of Supervisors Minutes
December 29, 2025

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. December 29, 2025. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, David Turner; 3rd District Supervisor, Heather Knebel and 4th District Supervisor, Mark Doland. Also, Tama County Auditor, Karen Rohrs, and members of the public. Absent: 5th District Supervisor, Curt Kupka.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion by Turner, seconded by Knebel to approve the agenda. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Public Comments: There were no comments from the public. Public time closed at 8:31 am.

Motion by Hilmer, seconded by Turner to approve the minutes of the December 22nd regular meeting. Discussion: None. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. The two road crew foreman positions were discussed. An offer of employment had been made to Taylor House and Terry Purvis and both accepted the offer. House and Purvis will start the foreman positions on January 5th.
